

Lab 10: Head Games**Due: 12/7/09 in class****Objectives of the Lab:** to decipher headers

You will be given 3 emails (yahoo, gmail, Outlook) with respective pertinent headers – they serve to represent the following scenarios.

Scenario 1:**The Problem: Plagiarism**

On June 2, 2009, Semain King published a book called “Tears of the Dove” about a catastrophic affair that left a family in despair, until the son discovered he had magic powers to solve his family’s problems.

In December 2009, James Green (defendant) published a book called “Time to Cry” about a catastrophic affair that left a family in despair, until the son discovered he had magic powers to solve his family’s problems.

In March 2010 Semain King sued James Green. James denies the charge and his lawyers produce an email that clearly documents communications between James and his agent, Daniel Craig in which James had sent the manuscript in Jan 2009, months before Semain’s book was published.

Scenario 2:**The Problem: Fired**

A former employee of NabiCore.edu (alias for Millersville.edu), Penny Man, is fired for not responding to a critical customer situation in August 2007. She sues; her defense being that she was extremely sick and had informed her supervisor, Pierce Brosnan (defendant). She has an email communiqué to show as her evidence.

Pierce Brosnan acknowledges sending the email and receiving a response from Penny but claims that he does not believe Penny’s story.

Scenario 3:**The Problem: Stalker**

Jane Sey lives in the village of Nordinburgh, Scotland. She claims that her neighbor, Sean Connery (defendant), is stalking her and also is sending her unwanted emails. Sean denies this and in fact claims that even if Jane was the last woman on earth, he still would have no interest in the likes of her. Jane takes Sean to court. In the presence of the entire village, her lawyer ostentatiously produces an email evidence from Oct 2009.

What to hand in

You are security expert who is responsible for reviewing the evidence and recommending if the defendant should be inculpated or exculpated.

For each of the scenario, complete the following report (clear, concise, concrete) that will be used as part of the evidence packet presented in court.
