

## Lion Roars and Whines

### **Zooming Screen**

Need to turn on for a new account. Preferences / Universal Access / Seeing / Zoom / Options at bottom choose "Use scroll wheel with modifier keys to zoom" with ^ (for control key)

### **Scroll**

It scrolls backwards from what Snow Leopard did on trackpad. But it's similar to how it works on iPhone and iPad. And you don't see the scroll bars until/while scrolling. Change this in System Preferences / General. I set Show scroll bars to Always. I also like Click in the scroll bar to Jump to the spot that's clicked.

### **No Rosetta**

Applications from PowerPC (not compiled for Intel) will not run. That includes Quicken, Office 2004, and AppleWorks.

### **Home directory and Hard Disk not visible by default**

Not in Finder until you put it there. Finder / Preferences / Sidebar ~/Library is hidden. Hold down option key when selecting Go menu and Library is there.

### **"Safe" files**

In Safari (and other web browsers), Preferences / General uncheck Open "safe" files after downloading"

### **Full screen mode**

Two arrow icon in upper right corner. Use esc (escape) key to go back to normal.

### **Spell correction as you type**

Typing in some apps (such as TextEdit) will do word completion as on iPhone. (But you still need to type the period.)

### **Unsaved indicator**

Previously, there was a black dot in red close control on window to indicate that file was edited. Now -Edited appears near file name on title bar. This makes the status more obvious. But it is only in updated apps and didn't happen for older apps. There are many more features in TextEdit.
